Requires proof of identification from sellers of agricultural commodities. Establishes criminal penalties for failure to maintain a certificate of ownership or other written proof of ownership of agricultural commodities. Makes theft of agricultural commodities an offense of theft in the second degree and establishes lack of ownership or movement certificates as prima facie evidence of the theft. <u>Status & Testimony</u> | RELATING TO VETERINARY MEDICINE.
Establishes a spay and neuter special fund and allows funds from an income tax check-off to be deposited into the special fund. Effective 07/01/12 to 07/01/17. (Proposed SD2) | CPN, JDL |
