Status

RELATING TO THE BOILER AND ELEVATOR SAFETY LAW.
Establishes the boiler and elevator special fund to collect and deposit fees for inspections, permits, and examinations of boilers, pressure systems, elevators, and kindred equipment; provides for sufficient operating costs to carry out the purpose of the boiler and elevator safety law. Appropriates funds for start up costs and hiring of necessary staff. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)

PAPER: 3 copies (including an original) to Room 422 in the State Capitol;


