Authorizes the Department of Transportation to extend the term of an airport concession, and to modify and amend the terms of any concession lease or contract in exchange for revenue-enhancing improvements that are made or paid for by the concession. Effective July 1, 2012.	TIA, WAM
<a href="#"><u>SB 3040</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION. Exempts from the rental motor vehicle and tour vehicle surcharge tax vehicles that are rented by a car-sharing organization to members of the organization on an hourly basis.	TIA, WAM
<a href="#"><u>SB 2946</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION. <u>Extends the increase in the rental motor vehicle surcharge tax to \$7.50 per day until June 30, 2013, and deposits \$4.50 per day of the tax into the general fund until that date; extends the suspension of the rental motor vehicle customer facility charges until June 30, 2013.</u>	<a href="#"><u>TIA, WAM</u></a> <a href="#"><u>[Measure added on 02-03-12]</u></a>
<a href="#"><u>SB 2874</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO AIRPORT REVENUE. Amends Sections 261-7 and 171-59 Hawaii Revised Statutes to provide more flexibility in renting land and facilities at airports for revenue generation purposes.	TIA, WAM
<a href="#"><u>SB 2960</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO AERONAUTICS. Beginning , 2012, prohibits the department of transportation from assessing landing fees upon air carriers operating turboprop engine air craft that provide interisland service, except between the most populous island in the State and any other island in the State. <a href="#"><u>SB 2977</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO TAXATION. Creates an income tax credit for aviation fuel taxes paid by interisland airplane carriers to transport people and goods between the islands of this State using turbo propeller airplanes.	TIA, WAM
