| <p><b><u>HB 2277, HD1</u></b><br/><a href="#"><u>(HSCR960-12)</u></a><br/><a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a></p> | <p>RELATING TO ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES.<br/>Addresses the conditions under which a minor may operate an all-terrain vehicle. Establishes requirements and prohibited acts for owners, operators, and sellers of all-terrain vehicles. Effective January 7, 2059. (HB2277 HD1)</p>  | <p>TIA, JDL</p> |
| <p><b><u>HB 2684, HD2</u></b><br/><a href="#"><u>(HSCR760-12)</u></a><br/><a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a></p> | <p>RELATING TO THE ZIPPER LANE.<br/>Requires the Department of Transportation to conduct a feasibility study on the extension of the zipper lane westward from Waipahu toward Kapolei, west of the Kunia on-ramp. Requires the Department of Transportation to submit a report to the Legislature twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2014. Appropriates funds for the study. Effective July 1, 2030. (HB2684 HD2)</p>   | <p>TIA, WAM</p> |
| <p><b><u>HB 2004, HD2</u></b><br/><a href="#"><u>(HSCR757-12)</u></a><br/><a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a></p> | <p>RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.<br/>Temporarily authorizes the Department of Transportation to extend the term of an airport concession, and to modify and amend the terms of any concession contract, lease, or permit in exchange for revenue-enhancing improvements that are made or paid for by the concession. Effective July 1, 2030. (HB2004 HD2)</p>   | <p>TIA, WAM</p> |
| <p><b><u>HB 2800, HD1</u></b><br/><a href="#"><u>(HSCR901-12)</u></a><br/><a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a></p> | <p>RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.<br/>Extends the increase in the Rental Motor Vehicle Surcharge Tax for five years. Extends the suspension of the \$4.50 per day Rental Motor Vehicle Customer Facility Charge for an additional five years. Requires the rental motor vehicle surcharge taxes assessed and collected during the fiscal years 2012-2013 to 2016-2017 to be transmitted to the Director of Finance. Requires the Director of Finance to deposit a specified amount of funds collected into the general fund and the remainder of the funds into the Rental Motor Vehicle Customer Facility Charge Special Fund. Provides the Director of Finance with the discretion to determine when the taxes assessed and collected during a fiscal year will be deposited into the specified funds. Effective June 29, 2012.
