Proposed SD1: Increases the allocation of the transient accommodations tax revenue for the Hawaii tourism authority from \$69,000,000 to \$71,000,000; requires \$2,000,000 to be expended for development and implementation of initiatives to take advantage of expanded visa programs and increased travel opportunities for international visitors to Hawaii. (SD1)
