HB 2078, HD2 (HSCR805-12) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO TAXATION. Requires that all advertisements and solicitations in any medium for transient accommodations to conspicuously display the registration identification number or the website address for a website containing the registration identification number. Requires that any advertisement or solicitation that appears on any website provide contact information for a local agent if the operator of the residential property resides off-island or out-of-state. Applies beginning January 1, 2013. (HB2078 HD2)	TSM, CPN
