| <u>HB 2591, HD2</u> <u>(HSCR701-12)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u> | RELATING TO ACCRETED LANDS. Clarifies that land accreted after May 20, 2003, shall be public land except as otherwise provided by law. (HB2591 HD2) | WLH/JDL, WAM |
| <u>HB 2594, HD2</u> <u>(HSCR870-12)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u> | PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE VII, SECTION 12, OF THE HAWAII STATE CONSTITUTION TO ASSIST DAM AND RESERVOIR OWNERS. Proposes a constitutional amendment to authorize the State to issue special purpose revenue bonds and use the proceeds from the bonds to assist dam and reservoir owners make their facilities compliant with current safety standards.
