| <p><b><u>SB 2597</u></b><br/><a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a></p> | <p>RELATING TO THE HAWAII LEGACY TRUST FUND.<br/>Establishes the Hawaii legacy trust fund as a separate fund of the Hawaii Community Foundation to encourage individuals to make strong financial investments while supporting conservation, reforestation, environmental stewardship, sustainability, affordable housing, public education, and the well-being of the State's keiki and kupuna.</p> | <p>WLH, WAM</p> |
| <p><b><u>SB 2377</u></b><br/><a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a></p> | <p>RELATING TO HUNTING.<br/>Requires written permission from a landowner of privately owned land to allow persons with valid hunting licenses to hunt on their land. Allows the carrying of unloaded firearms and ammunition, in a closed container, between certain locations and a place of formal hunting.</p>  | <p>WLH, JDL</p> |

Requires the department of land and natural resources to establish a statewide program, in cooperation with licensed hunters, to reduce the population of feral ungulates on public lands; requires reports to the legislature prior to the convening of the regular sessions of 2013 and 2014. <a href="#"><u>SB 2305</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO OCEAN RESOURCES. Deletes the "one-gallon per person per day" exception to the prohibition against the removal of sand and other beach or marine deposits, except for materials inadvertently taken, such as those carried away on the body, clothes, toys, recreational equipment, and bags. <a href="#"><u>SB 2664</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO MARINE LIFE. Establishes a special fund for the marine life conservation program, and authorizes the collection of user fees for marine life conservation districts.	WLH, WAM
<a href="#"><u>SB 2667</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO WATER. Establishes a joint legislative committee to delineate the meaning of water security and establish benchmarks.	WLH, WAM
<a href="#"><u>SB 2850</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO GROUNDED VESSELS. Authorizes the Department of Land and Natural Resources to assume control of and remove a vessel grounded on a coral reef or in imminent danger of breaking up if the vessel cannot be removed by the owner within twenty-four hours of the grounding. <a href="#"><u>SB 2857</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS TO ASSIST DAM AND RESERVOIR OWNERS. Allows the authorization of special purpose revenue bonds to assist dam and reservoir owners.	WLH, WAM
