Status

RELATING TO THE PUBLIC TRUST LANDS.

WLO/HAW, JUD, FIN

Conveys Kakaako Makai lands to Office of Hawaiian Affairs, and resolves all disputes and controversies, and extinguishes, discharges and bars all claims, suits, and actions relating to OHA's portion of income and proceeds from the public trust lands for the period

November 7, 1978 through June 30, 2012
