RELATING TO COMMUNITY PLANNING.
Establishes planning districts and creates a process for developers to apply for residential and commercial exceptional planning projects. Establishes the transit-oriented or main-street redevelopment program. Authorizes state and county incentives for exceptional planning projects. Establishes a discretionary review process for the transfer of floor area within the planning district. Effective 07/01/2050. (SD2)

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

- The date and time of the hearing;
- Measure number; and
- The number of copies the Committee is requesting.



While every effort will be made to copy, organize, and collate all testimony received, materials received on the day of the hearing or improperly identified or directed to the incorrect office, may be distributed to the Committee after the hearing.

Submit testimony in ONE of the following ways:

WEB: For comments less than 10MB in size, transmit from <http://www.capitol.hawaii.gov/submittestimony.aspx>.


Testimony submitted will be placed on the Legislative Web site after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the Web site should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
