<a href="#"><u>SB2332, SD2</u></a>	RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. Exempts home-based agricultural producers of honey from the requirement that honey be processed in a certified honey house; provided that the producer meets certain labeling, education, and record keeping requirements. (SD2)	HLT, FIN
<a href="#"><u>SB2872</u></a>	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Allow any utility owners whose facility occupies State Highway right-of-way to provide their share of costs up front to the affected state agency for encumbrance of funds in related contracts by way of an agreement to pay.	TRN, FIN

**RELATING TO COMMUNITY PLANNING.**

Establishes planning districts and creates a process for developers to apply for residential and commercial exceptional planning projects. Establishes the transit-oriented or main-street redevelopment program. Authorizes state and county incentives for exceptional planning projects. Establishes a discretionary review process for the transfer of floor area within the planning district. Effective 07/01/2050. (SD2)
