This is my response to your questions regarding my nomination to the Enhanced 911 Board.

## 1. Why do you wish to be a member of the Wireless Enhanced 911 Board?

The 911 Board plays a critical part in overseeing the development, integration and maintenance of enhanced 911 services Statewide. Public safety has been my passion for many years. There is a continuing need for better efficiency in 911 service and I would like to be a direct contributor to this endeavor.

2. Given your understanding of the role and responsibilities of a member of the Wireless Enhanced 911 Board, why do you believe that you are qualified for the position? Please include a brief statement of your skills, expertise, or knowledge that would aid in your decision-making ability as a member of the Wireless Enhanced 911 Board.

I have over 21 years of experience in public safety in Hawaii. I have significant experience managing large procurements within the State, and have also been directly involved in overseeing the annual budget for our Police Department (approximately \$26 million). I am the project manager for Kauai's next-generation 911 call-handling project and have conducted significant research in this area.

## 3. What do you hope to accomplish during your term of service?

There are critical technical capabilities that have not yet been deployed for 911 service in the State of Hawaii. We still do not have the ability to receive text messages, photos and video via 911 calls. This significantly restricts the ability of some disabled citizens and others who are in situations that prevent them from using our currently deployed 911 system. During my term of service, I would like to help facilitate a Statewide movement towards enhanced 911 services that accommodate people who are unable to speak during a time of emergency.

4. Can you foresee any possible conflicts of interests that could arise during your service on the Wireless Enhanced 911 Board? How would you overcome any possible conflicts of interest?

I do not believe there will be any conflicts of interest for me should I be selected to the Board. If a conflict of interest arose, I would disclose the conflict and recuse myself from any deliberations involving that conflict.
