The Department of Human Services (DHS) supports the nomination of Mr. Carl Makino to the State Commission on Fatherhood.

Mr. Makino is seeking an appointment to fill the remaining term of a vacant position. Mr. Makino brings to the Commission over 30 years of public service with the University of Hawaii at Manoa, starting as a counselor in the Financial Aid Office and rising to the position of Executive Assistant to the Board of Regents. After his retirement with the University of Hawaii, he worked for the Salvation Army as a case worker in the Family Treatment Services for almost three years. His work with the Salvation Army included providing parenting classes for new fathers, educational and vocational counseling, domestic violence prevention training, job search, relapse prevention, and assisting in entering substance abuse treatment programs. He has also worked as a

counselor to incarcerated inmates (including inmates who are fathers) in all of the correction facilities in Oahu. Mr. Makino's extensive education, administrative, and counseling background will be of great benefit to the State Fatherhood Commission.

Mr. Makino will provide representation to the Commission as the State Senate's representative.
