UNEMPLOYMENT RATE

- Hawaii's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate has increased by at least 0.1 percentage points each month from June 2011 to October. It remained unchanged from October to November and grew by 0.1 percentage point in December.
- The 12-month moving average shows that the decline in unemployment rate for the State was leveling off, but now shows a slight increase.
