The City and County of Honolulu (City) supports the adoption of House Bill 2347.

The proposed amendment to HRS Chapter 47-4 would allow the City to pledge certain receipts (including but not limited to rates, rentals, fees, charges, taxes, state or federal grants) in addition to real property taxes to secure its general obligation bonds. Such an additional pledge would provide greater security for bondholders, thereby possibly lowering borrowing costs and strengthening the City's bond ratings.
