Aloha Chair Hanohano, Vice Chair Lee and Members of the Committee,

Thank you for the opportunity to testify in support of HB 2528. This bill extends the repeal date in Act 187 to continue the pilot program that enables the DHHL to begin housing and other projects without having the full amount of the cost of the projects on hand at the start of the project. Throughout the Hawaiian Islands, many of our moku practitioners are beneficiaries of the Hawaiian Homes Lands Trust and are entitled to the housing projects initiated by DHHL. However, since Act 187 was passed in 2010, the economic conditions in Hawaii made it impossible for the program to start. We believe the timing may be right in 2012 and in the near future as the economic picture improves.

We believe Act 187 is beneficial to our people, and the repeal date should be extended until 2015 as requested.

We support HB 2528..
