

PETITIONTO: Hawaii State SenateSUBJECT: Air Pollution Control

RESOLUTION: Crematoriums in the State of Hawaii that were in operation prior to March 20, 1972 are currently exempt from air pollution control permitting requirements. In the best interest of public health and for a cleaner environment, we petition to revise Hawaii Revised Statute 342B to include these exempt crematoriums to obtain an air pollution control permit.

PROPOSED AMEMDMENT TO HRS 342B: "All crematoriums of human remains operating within the State shall be subject to the permit requirements of this chapter; provided that owners or operators of crematoriums operating within the State without a permit which were constructed prior to March 20, 1972 shall submit permit applications to the department by December 31, 2012. The department may adopt rules pursuant to Chapter 91 to effectuate the purposes of this section or to impose permit conditions to minimize ambient air quality impacts caused by crematoriums."
