MEASURE: H.B No. 2670

TITLE: Relating to Energy.

Chair Coffman and Members of the Committee:

DESCRIPTION: Establishes the negotiated partner approach pilot program for energy savings contracts, which allows agencies to forego requests for proposals and negotiate directly with qualified vendors. Requires the pilot program to be operational from 7/1/12 to 6/30/14.

POSITION: Honeywell supports H.B. 2670 - Relating to Energy.

COMMENTS: We believe the State of Hawaii agencies are not consistent in their implementation or administration of their energy and sustainability goals and objectives despite rising energy cost and reduced funding. Many do not seem to be able to put together a strategic and comprehensive program.

Here is Life of the land's proposed amendment for HB 2670

page 2, lines 14-19

"The pilot program shall: 14 (1) Allow any state agency to negotiate directly with a <u>miniumum of three</u> vendors on the list of qualified vendors for a sole-source energy savings performance contract for one building or structure under the agency's jurisdiction, <u>and to choose one vendor based on written guidelines developed by the agency</u>, not withstanding chapter 1,030, Hawaii Revised Statutes;
