Aloha Chair Aquino, Vice-Chair Cullen, and Members of the Committee:

The Department of Hawaiian Home Lands (DHHL) strongly supports this resolution and the proposed Maui Regional Public Safety Complex at Puunene.

Our department owns 834 acres adjacent to the proposed complex site, and the complex will bring much needed infrastructure to this region. With the road and water infrastructure, we can develop agricultural homestead lots, as well as commercial and industrial parcels to generate revenue sustain our trust. As the head of this Hawaiian trust, I also acknowledge that many of the state's inmates are Native Hawaiian, and this project creates opportunities to bring them home.
