BUDGET BRIEFING TESTIMONY OF THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR TO THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON FINANCE AND SENATE COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET REQUEST FOR FISCAL YEAR 2012-2013

TWENTY-SIXTH LEGISLATURE REGULAR SESSION JANUARY 5, 2012

TO THE HONORABLE MARCUS OSHIRO AND DAVID IGE, CHAIRS AND MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEES:

My name is Bruce Coppa, Chief of Staff for the Office of the Governor. Thank you for this opportunity to present and discuss the budget for our office for Fiscal Year 2012-2013.

Mission Statement

To enhance the effectiveness and efficiency of state programs by providing Executive direction, policy development, program coordination, and planning and budgeting.

Context

Transforming Government Services for the People of Hawaii - Current economic conditions continue to place a strain on certain government operations statewide. The Governor's Office is not immune to these effects. The Governor's Office general fund appropriation in the current budget act is \$3,176,357, which is the same as for Fiscal Year 2009-2010. Except for the gubernatorial transition last year (FY2011), this amount is the lowest appropriation for the Governor's Office since 2006.

However, because of labor savings (-\$80,926) and the transfer of the operations of Washington Place to the Department of Accounting and General Services (-\$103,048), the requested general fund appropriation for the Office of the Governor for Fiscal Year 2012-2013 is now \$2,921,286.

With regards to the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA), the Office of the Governor was directly responsible for the expenditure of the State Fiscal Stabilization Fund (SFSF). The Part A funds were distributed and expended by the Department of Education and the University of Hawaii. The Part B funds were distributed via grants by the prior

administration. The Office of the Governor does not face any direct "funding cliff" as a result of the end of this program. In addition, the Office of the Governor does not directly receive any other federal funds. There is therefore no significant loss likely to occur to the Office of the Governor.

Alternatives Considered

The Abercrombie Administration has diligently worked to secure additional non-state resources for state programs. Specifically, the Office of the Governor has hired four positions that use some portion of non-state funds. These policy level positions assist the Governor, and moreover, the state in the areas of education, early childhood development, and healthcare transformation.

The Office of the Governor is also proposing to transfer the maintenance and upkeep of Washington Place to the Department of Accounting and General Services. This department has the requisite expertise and resources in the maintenance of the state's physical plant.
