TESTIMONY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

SENATE BILL NO. 1320

COMMITTEE ON

The **Department of Transportation supports Senate Bill 1320** which would amend the portions of the respective statutes concerning alcohol concentration for commercial motor vehicle drivers to make them consistent with current language.

Senate Bill 1320 amends section 286-131, 286-240(a), 286-242(b) and (c) and 286-243(d) and (e) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes.

The proposed amendments to the language of sections 286-231, 286-240, 286-242 and 286-243 HRS will make it consistent with the current language of section 291E-61 HRS – Operating a vehicle under the influence of an intoxicant.
