- 7 Legislation which offered alternative language for section 2, lines 12-15 which would provide greater
- 8 clarity as to the intent of the measure and would be less confusing by substituting "an anatomical gift
- 9 made under this chapter shall be accepted unless the anatomical gift is medically unsuitable for
- transplantation, therapy, research, or education."
