SB 2030, SD2, HD1

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

Chair Oshiro, Vice Chair Lee and committee members, thank you for the opportunity to testify on SB 2030, SD2, HD1. This bill essentially proposes to allow for specific corrections to the bid, 'scope of work for a listed subcontractor to be expanded', as a mistake after bids are received.

Section 103D-302(g) allows for correction or withdrawal of submitted bids. Corrections or mistakes in bids may be corrected if deemed an obvious mistake such as math error in price extensions, or minor informality which does not affect price, quality, quantity, delivery, or contractual conditions. Any correction of bids after contract award requires careful consideration to maintain the integrity of the competitive bidding system, to assure fairness, and to avoid delays or poor contract performance.

This proposed amendment will provide flexibility to the procurement officer to allow a change to the scope of work for a listed subcontractor that was not initially identified in the offer, which currently is not allowed.

Honorable Chair(s), Vice Chair(s) and Committee Members;

The Hawaii Building & Construction Trades Council, AFL-CIO which was originally chartered in October of 1958 is comprised of 16 out of 17 construction trade unions throughout Hawaii. With an estimated membership of 20,000 statewide, our primary mission is to provide employment opportunities and living wages for the many working men and women we represent.

The Council OPPOSES SB2030, SD2, HD1, which allows the procurement officer to expand the scope of work in a bid for a listed subcontractor, with certain conditions, after bid opening.

We specifically oppose Section 2(g)(1) of this measure and respectfully offer the following amendment for your consideration.

SECTION 2. Section 103D-302, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (g) to read as follows:

- "(g) Correction or withdrawal of inadvertently erroneous bids before or after award, or cancellation of invitations for bids, awards, or contracts based on such bid mistakes, shall be permitted in accordance with rules adopted by the policy board. After bid [opening] due date no changes in bid prices or other provisions of bids prejudicial to the interest of the public or to fair competition shall be permitted[-]; provided that the procurement officer may:
 - Allow the scope of work for a listed subcontractor to be expanded

 prior to bid due date for clarification purposes only [within five

 working days of bid opening]; provided further that the listed

 subcontractor possesses the proper contractor's license to include

 the expanded work; and

The General Contractors Association (GCA) is an organization comprised of over six hundred (600) general contractors, subcontractors, and construction related firms. The GCA was established in 1932 and is celebrating its 80th anniversary this year; GCA remains the largest construction association in the State of Hawaii whose mission is to represent its members in all matters related to the construction industry, while improving the quality of construction and protecting the public interest. GCA <u>strongly supports</u> the passage of S.B. 2030, SD2, HD1, Relating to Procurement, and respectfully requests removing the defective date and replacing it with "upon approval."

S.B. 2030, SD2, HD1 amends the current procurement procedure by amending Section 103D-302, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) to allow the procurement officer to expand the scope of work in a bid for a listed subcontractor, with certain conditions after bid opening. This measure also permits the procurement officer to consider a bid valid if a listed subcontractor's license had been suspended or forfeited at bid time due to ministerial reasons, provided the license is reinstated before award.

The GCA believes this measure will increase efficiency in the procurement process by allowing the procurement officer the ability to expand the scope of work of a listed subcontractor within five days of bid opening, eliminating such issue as a reason to protest. This bill will also allow a previously licensed and listed subcontractor whose license was not valid at bid time a period to cure any discrepancies due to ministerial issues under Chapter 444, Hawaii Revised Statutes, prior to the award date. The GCA

believes this measure will reduce the number of bid protests, which often increases costs and delays public works projects.

The GCA <u>strongly supports</u> the passage of S.B. 2030, SD2, HD1 and respectfully requests removing the defective date and replacing it with "upon approval."
