Chair Chun-Oakland and Members of the Committee:

I am Louis Erteschik, Acting Executive Director at the Hawaii Disability Rights Center, and am testifying in opposition to this bill.

We question the rationale for the bill and the purpose behind it. We prepare many advance directives- both medical as well as psychiatric- for our clients who want them. In fact, it is a good, pro- active measure for an individual to take if they feel it is warranted or worthwhile.

Yet, while this may be valuable for some individuals, we fail to see what interest the government has in mandating that anyone prepare such a document. Furthermore, to mandate that only Medicaid recipients prepare such a document seems discriminatory, inasmuch as there appears to be no logical basis for singling out that group of individuals. Any distinction based solely upon being a Medicaid recipient would be very questionable in its legality or constitutional stature.
