In consideration of **SENATE BILL 2502** RELATING TO ANIMAL CRUELTY

Senate Bill 2502 proposes to prohibit the use of certain lethal methods for the control of animals. The Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) appreciates the intent of this bill and is committed to working with partners to protect pets and ensure the humane treatment of animals. However, the Department has concerns that the bill, as written, may prohibit certain activities that are legally required or statutorily mandated for the protection of natural resources.

For example, many of the Department's critical wildlife management areas consist of wetlands that are located in urban areas and could be construed as residential. For example, Kawainui Marsh, a wetland of international significance that is essential for the protection and recovery of Hawaii's endangered waterbirds, is located near a residential setting. The Department also has concerns in cases where a private landowner is legally required to conduct effective predator control as part of a Habitat Conservation Plan or other legal settlement.

The Department therefore suggests amendments to ensure that those special cases are excluded from the prohibitions. The Department recommends amending Section 711- (2)(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes, to include "or authorized agents" of state or federal agencies.

SECTION 3.

§711- Cruelty to animals by trapping. ...

- (2) Subsection (1) shall not apply to: ...
- Employees or authorized agents of state or federal agencies who are carrying out (b) activities required under a management plan approved by state or federal

Dear Members of Senate Judiciary:

On behalf of Born Free USA, a nationally recognized leader in animal welfare and wildlife conservation, as well as our Hawaii membership, I write to express strong support for SB 2502, an important bill that would protect the public from indiscriminate snares, Conibear, and foot- or leg-hold traps by penalizing usage in residential areas.

Prohibiting the use of these traps in residential areas will not only protect communities and animals from unnecessary suffering, but it will also balance the expectations of many Hawaii residents who prefer trapping-free outdoor recreation.

Because of their non-selectivity, both targeted and non-targeted animals – including family cats and dogs, threatened and endangered species -- fall victim to traps. Born Free USA has documented through a comprehensive review of scientific literature that trapped animals may suffer severe physical injury, thirst, hypothermia, and predation. They may even remain in traps for days before dying.

Born Free USA keeps a database that reveals hundreds of incidents where traps have injured and killed cats, dogs and other non-target victims, including humans—and these are just the *reported* cases. We recently conducted an investigation which demonstrated that, despite years of research, there have been no significant advances in reducing this "collateral damage."

Hawaii law does require information to be collected regarding the number and species of non-target animals trapped and killed throughout the state. Requiring trappers to report the number and type of non-target victims will provide the state a more accurate estimate of species impacted by trapping and will aid in addressing and reducing non-target catches.

Please pass SB 2502 today.
