Relating to Animal Cruelty: Snares- trapping

Dear Honorable Chair Hee, Vice-Chair Shimabukuro and Members,

The Hawaiian Humane Society supports the passage of SB2502 in order to better protect animals from snares, conibears and leg-hold traps as they are cruel, antiquated means of trapping.

We support this measure for the following reasons:

- Steel-jawed traps are not currently in use by any state or federal agency and are prohibited in a number of states, banned in 89 other countries and opposed by the American Veterinary Medical Association and the American Animal Hospital Association
- Prohibiting snares, conibears and leg-hold traps in areas zoned as residential will further
 protect pet animals that may fall victim to them. Pet dogs and cats, are known to chew off
 their own limbs in an attempt to escape, causing severe injury or death.
- This bill requires that any pet captured using a snare or foot-hold trap be checked for identification and reported to the local humane society for reunion with their owner or adoption.
- The bill provides exemptions for state and federal agencies and their authorized agents in protecting threatened and endangered species or other wildlife.

I, Frances P. Pueo - support SB#2502.

In the early 1970's at a Kailua, Oahu Hardware Store there on the shelf were approximately 5 to 7 steel jaw traps that could be purchased by anyone. I approached the manager of the store with my objections that such cruel devices as these traps were made available for sale without forethought of its harmful use towards animals or to humans.

At that time, I was not sure if it was illegal for anyone to bring these traps into our state. The manager did not seem to grasp the extent of cruelty these devices causes to animals or humans.

To ensure it would not be sold I bought all the traps in stock, and turned it over the Oahu Humane Society and then wrote to Senator Dan Inouye and other Congress Representatives.

So now, 40 years later....beyond belief that such devices or similar devices as animal snares are in use in our state! And without regulations, any form of control, or any penalties for misuse.

Animal snares are in use on this island. In Keaau I had dismantled 21 animal snares made from everything from string, cord, wire, and with spikes into the ground to increase the animal suffering.

I am direct witness to see pigs missing part of their legs struggling to forage for food on three legs. I am direct witness to see animals with snare ties around their ankles, buried into their flesh showing bone. Weaken, and struggling to survive.

On one occasion, 9 feral piglets were observed to have rope tied around their ankles, from being caught and escaping the animal snare traps. As they grew, the rope buried into their flesh and then into their bone. These animals were showing signs of suffering and pain barely able to walk. The wounds were large, exposing muscle tissue, torn flesh and bone, obvious massive infection. To capture these animals a humane (live) drop trap were used.

I am also witness to find dead cats in snares; I am also witness to find cats that have chewed off part of their limbs to free themselves from the snares. Of eight cats caught in animal snares, two did not survive the amputation surgery because of the massive infection.

People that are setting these animal snares must be held accountable as it is horrible animal cruelty and the only way to get them to stop is to make it a crime with a severe penalty – misdemeanor/heavy fine – I rather it be made into a felony.

Remember this - Small children or toddlers can equally walk into these animal snares and metal steel jaws of death.
