## S.B. 2537 Relating To Charter Schools

The Hawaii Government Employees Association, HGEA/AFSCME, Local 152, AFL-CIO opposes S.B. 2537. The purpose of this bill is to amend 302B-9 by amending subsection (a) to allow the charter schools to enter into either supplemental agreements or master agreements separate from any other master agreement collectively bargained for between the exclusive representatives and department, as defined in chapter 89.

We recommend that 302B-9 not be amended thereby charter schools retain the authority to negotiate supplemental agreements with the exclusive representatives..
