SENATE BILL NO. 2691 RELATING TO THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE

Chairperson Nishihara and Members of the Committee:

Thank you for the opportunity to provide testimony on SB 2691. This bill proposes to allow ex-officio members of the Board of Agriculture to designate a representative to attend board meetings in their stead.

The Department strongly supports this bill. Currently, HRS section 26-16 requires that the Board of Agriculture be made up of 10 members, three of which are ex officio voting members: the Chairperson for the Board of Land and Natural Resources, the Director of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism, and the Dean of the University of Hawaii College of Tropical Agriculture and Human Resources. Often the busy schedules of these ex officio members make it extremely difficult for them to attend board meetings and their inability to attend has resulted in failure of the Board to act on matters requiring timely action

In consideration of SENATE BILL 2691 RELATING TO THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE

Senate Bill 2691 seeks to allow ex officio members of the Board of Agriculture to designate a representative to attend Board meetings in their place. The Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) strongly supports this Administrative measure.
