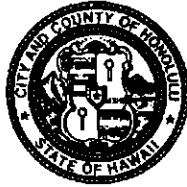

The Department of Planning and Permitting **supports** Senate Bill No. 2742, SD1, which adjusts the membership of the Hawaii Community Development Authority (HCDA). We particularly support the change that would add the director of the City and County of Honolulu, Department of Planning and Permitting as an ex-officio, voting member, who would be allowed to designate a representative.

As one of the ex-officio HCDA members for Kalaehoa only, there have been occasions when I could not attend meetings. It would have been worthwhile to HCDA and the public to hear the benefit of the City's perspectives at these meetings via a designated representative. Moreover, the City's perspectives can be helpful, particularly on matters of mutual interest, such as infrastructure and transit-oriented development.
