Chair Aquino, Vice-Chair Cullen and Committee Members:

I am Major General Darryll D. M. Wong, State Adjutant General. I am testifying on Senate Bill 2771 SD1.

We appreciate the Hawaii State Legislature for their strong support to provide the emergency appropriations in Senate Bill 2771 SD1for costs incurred in support of the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) meetings in November 2011.

However, through the hard work of all the State, county, and federal agencies that supported APEC, we were able to secure approval and funds through a National Security Special Event (NSSE) grant from the U.
