SB 2803 SD1, Relating to Childcare Contract Proposals

The Hawaii Association for the Education of Young Children (HAEYC) offers this testimony in <u>support</u> of SB 2803 SD1. This measure prohibits the performance of a contract for childcare, pursuant to chapter 103F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, rather than acceptance of a contract proposal, by any applicant who lacks an appropriate license. Requiring an applicant to have a license in order to submit a funding proposal ensures the quality of available childcare services.
