Papa Ola Lokahi, the Native Hawaiian Health Board, does not have a position on this measure except to indicate that there may be requirements within 46CFR169 which are not applicable to traditional Pacific Islands' voyaging canoes such as the Hokule`a, Hawai`iloa, and other such sailing vessels. We would suggest that language be added to this measure to protect the abilities of our traditional voyaging canoes to continue to be considered as " sailing school vessels. " The Polynesian Voyaging Society and the Friends of Hokule`a and Hawai`iloa and others play critical roles in the education of our people in Hawai`i and in the Pacific and in the perpetuation of traditional voyaging and wayfinding.
