Application for Grants and Subsidies

I. Background and Summary

- 1. Applicant's background Gilad Productions Ltd. was Incorporated in the State of Hawaii on January 13th 1983 for the purpose of producing and distributing television fitness shows and home exercise instructional videos. To date the show has aired in more than 80 countries world-wide and nationally across the United States. This year marks the 30th anniversary of our TV show. The show features Gilad Janklowicz, a Hawaii resident, as host and executive producer of the show.
- 2. Goals and objectives Discovery Fit & Health cable network has contracted us to produce 10 new 30th anniversary episodes and offered \$55,000 to be used for the production of these shows. We need to raise \$50,000 more to complete the production. Along with the completion of these shows comes a contractual commitment from Discovery Fit & Health to run 'Bodies In Motion' on the air for 3 more years (until September of 2016) with additional option years. Failure to complete these episodes would mean that our contract to air 'Bodies In Motion' would expire in April 2014. Our goal is to keep 'Bodies In Motion on the air.
- 3. 'Bodies in Motion' is recorded in Hawaii and features the most beautifully scenic locations that Hawaii has to offer. In essence, each episode plays like a half hour promotional video for Hawaii tourism. In addition to the exposure Hawaii receives from the show itself Gilad Productions, Ltd is offering a sponsorship package to the state in exchange for the backing. This sponsorship package includes a. A. :10 sec. billboard that can serve as a direct response ad. B. In-show mentions and C. Credit acknowledgement in the credit roll. According to the Discovery sales department, the monetary value of this sponsorship package exceeds the amount of funding we are requesting from you for this project..
- 4. Our target market consists of motivated fitness minded and health conscious people. Traditionally our viewers are about 70% female ages 25+ and 30% male 25+. Demographic information from Discovery Fit & Health tells us the bulk of our viewers are middle income plus.
- 5. 'Bodies In Motion' airs on two national networks in the USA, Discovery Fit & Health, which reaches more than 50 million homes, and JLTV which reaches an estimated 42 million homes. 'Bodies In Motion' can be seen in all 50 states. It also airs in numerous foreign countries such as Australia, China, Mexico, Central America, the Caribbean, and several Far East and European countries.

II. Service Summary and Outcomes

- 1. Scope of work Gilad Productions, Ltd will complete all the tasks necessary to produce 10 new episodes of 'Bodies In Motion' for Discovery Fit & Health. These tasks include writing, casting, choreographing and rehearsing the new episodes. Gilad and Rob Hearn are the producers of the show. Production tasks include assembling a local crew, creating new music, determining locations for the shoot, scheduling the production shoot days, and editing the material to Discovery Communications specifications.
- 2. Gilad Productions is already in the process of doing the pre-production work and will continue in this phase through June, 2013. We will be shooting these new episodes in the month of July, 2013. We will be doing the post-production in the first 3 weeks of August, 2013. We will be delivering these episodes to Discovery Fit & Health at the end of August to begin airing Monday, September 2, 2013.
- 3. Gilad Productions, Ltd. has been producing episodes of 'Bodies In Motion' for 30 years. The show is well known for its high standards and quality of production. The show has won several awards including 'Best Fitness Show', 'The People's Choice Award' and a 'Telly Award' for 'Outstanding Television Program and Work'. Since we are producing these shows for Discovery Communications we must abide by their technical standards which are known to be some of the highest in the industry. Each show is viewed and scrutinized by their production team insuring the highest possible quality. Our goal is to make the new episodes a showcase of our abilities.
- 4. Gilad Productions, Ltd. will follow the measures of effectiveness of the State agency through which the funds are appropriated. We will attend all meetings required, file all financial reports and economic evaluations and submit samples of advertising and promotional efforts.

III. Financial

1. We are submitting our actual production budget and then summarizing the budget on the form supplied by the State. See the pages immediately following.

- 2. We will be borrowing the up-front production funds from the Bank of Hawaii and spending all of it during the months of July and August, 2013. We would like to recoup the money and pay off our loan as soon as possible but we are willing to accept quarterly payments if required by the State.
- 3. Our contract with Discovery Communications will net us \$55,000 upon completion and delivery of the shows. We are asking the State for funds to cover part of the production expenses. We are finalizing an agreement with Hawaiian Airlines to cover airfare to fly talent in from the mainland. Other than these agreements we are not seeking any other sources for funding.
- 4. Gilad Productions has been granted no federal tax credits in the last three years. This is a list of all Hawaii State tax credits:

5. Financial summary – Gilad Productions, Ltd. is asking for \$50,000 from the state to help fund the production of the new episodes of 'Bodies In Motion'. This will ensure that our broadcast contract will be extended for 3 more years until September, 2016. Discovery Communications has already committed \$55,000 to the project and in addition, Gilad Productions, Ltd. is investing \$25,000 and any other expenses that might occur.

- **A.** Necessary Skills and Experience Gilad Productions, Ltd. has produced approximately 500 fitness shows over the last 30 years with the same personnel in the managerial positions.
 - **B.** Facilities This project does not require the use of public facilities.

V. Personnel: Project Organization and Staffing

A. Proposed Staffing, Qualifications, Supervision and Training

There are 3 principal staff members that come together each time we have gone into production for the last 30 years. Gilad Janklowicz, President of Gilad Productions, Ltd develops the shows and serves as the Executive Producer, producer, writer, music director, choreographer and on-camera host.

Rob Hearn serves as a Producer and the Director. Rob and Gilad are responsible for personnel on the set on remote shoot days. Rob and Gilad also oversee each edit session.

Ray Battaglia serves as the Chief Engineer in charge of assembling the correct equipment and personnel to record the shows and adhere to Discovery Communications technical specifications.

All other personnel are locally hired specialists. The production community is small. Everybody has worked with everybody else on numerous projects and there is no guess work involved as to the capabilities of each individual.

- **A. Litigation** Gilad Productions Ltd. is not involved in any litigation.
- B. Licensure and Accreditation No licensing or accreditation is required for this kind of work. Quality of performance is based solely on experience.
