

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ENHANCED 911 BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 138-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) There is created within the department of accounting
4 and general services, for administrative purposes, an enhanced
5 911 board consisting of thirteen voting members; provided that
6 the membership shall consist of:

7 (1) The [~~comptroller~~] chief information officer or the
8 [~~comptroller's~~] chief information officer's designee;

9 (2) Three representatives from wireless communications
10 service providers, who shall be appointed by the
11 governor as provided in section 26-34;

12 (3) One representative each from the public safety
13 answering points for Oahu, Hawaii, Kauai, Maui, and
14 Molokai and one representative, chosen by the mayor of
15 the city and county of Honolulu, who shall be

1 appointed by the governor as provided in section 26-
2 34;

3 (4) The consumer advocate or the consumer advocate's
4 designee;

5 (5) One representative from a communications service
6 company that offers Interconnected Voice over Internet
7 Protocol services, who shall be appointed by the
8 governor as provided in section 26-34; and

9 (6) One representative of the public utility providing
10 telecommunications services and land line enhanced 911
11 services through section 269-16.95."

12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
