

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII INTERAGENCY COUNCIL ON HOMELESSNESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 346-382, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended as follows:

3 1. By amending subsection (a) to read:

4 "(a) The Hawaii interagency council on homelessness shall
5 be composed of the following members or the member's designee:

6 (1) Governor's coordinator on homelessness, who shall
7 serve as chair;

8 (2) Director of human services;

9 (3) Administrator of the homeless programs office of the
10 department of human services;

11 (4) Director of health;

12 (5) Director of labor and industrial relations;

13 (6) Director of public safety;

14 (7) Director of business, economic development, and
15 tourism;

16 (8) Chairperson of the Hawaiian homes commission;

17 (9) Adjutant general;



- 1 (10) Chairperson of the board of trustees of the office of
2 Hawaiian affairs;
- 3 (11) Attorney general;
- 4 (12) Superintendent of education;
- 5 (13) [~~One member~~] Two members of the house of
6 representatives to be designated by the speaker of the
7 house of representatives [~~+~~], of whom one member shall
8 be designated by the speaker of the house of
9 representatives to serve as an alternate member on the
10 Hawaii interagency council on homelessness to serve in
11 the other member's absence;
- 12 (14) [~~One member~~] Two members of the senate to be
13 designated by the president of the senate [~~+~~], of whom
14 one member shall be designated by the president of the
15 senate to serve as an alternate member on the Hawaii
16 interagency council on homelessness to serve in the

- 18 (15) A representative of the Hawaii public housing
19 authority;
- 20 [~~(15)~~] (16) The mayor of each county;

- 2 programs in each county, to be designated by the

17 "(c) [~~(f)~~] Except as provided in subsection (a)(13) and

18 (a)(14), if a member of the Hawaii interagency council on

19 homelessness [~~member~~] is unable to attend a meeting, that member

20 may appoint a designee to attend and to act on the member's



A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRODUCTION OF RECORDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 10H-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3 "(a) There is established a five-member Native Hawaiian
4 roll commission within the office of Hawaiian affairs for
5 administrative purposes only. The Native Hawaiian roll
6 commission shall be responsible for:
7 (1) Preparing and maintaining a roll of qualified Native
8 Hawaiians;
9 (2) Certifying that the individuals on the roll of
10 qualified Native Hawaiians meet the definition of
11 qualified Native Hawaiians. For purposes of
12 establishing the roll, a "qualified Native Hawaiian"
13 means an individual [~~who~~] whom the commission
14 determines has satisfied the following criteria and
15 who makes a written statement certifying that the
16 individual:



- 1 (A) Is:
- 2 (i) An individual who is a descendant of the
- 3 aboriginal peoples who, prior to 1778,
- 4 occupied and exercised sovereignty in the
- 5 Hawaiian islands, the area that now
- 6 constitutes the State of Hawaii; ~~[or]~~
- 7 (ii) An individual who is one of the indigenous,
- 8 native people of Hawaii and who was eligible
- 9 in 1921 for the programs authorized by the
- 10 Hawaiian Homes Commission Act, 1920, or a
- 11 direct lineal descendant of that individual;
- 12 or
- 13 (iii) An individual who meets the ancestry
- 14 requirements of Kamehameha Schools or of any
- 15 Hawaiian registry program of the office of
- 16 Hawaiian affairs;
- 17 (B) Has maintained a significant cultural, social, or
- 18 civic connection to the Native Hawaiian community
- 19 and wishes to participate in the organization of
- 20 the Native Hawaiian governing entity; and
- 21 (C) Is eighteen years of age or older; ~~[and]~~



1 (3) Receiving and maintaining documents that verify
2 ancestry; cultural, social, or civic connection to the
3 Native Hawaiian community; and age from individuals
4 seeking to be included in the roll of qualified Native
5 Hawaiians. Notwithstanding any other law to the
6 contrary, these verification documents shall be
7 confidential[-]; and

8 (4) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary,
9 including in the roll of qualified Native Hawaiians
10 all individuals already registered with the State as
11 verified Hawaiians or Native Hawaiians through the
12 office of Hawaiian affairs as demonstrated by the
13 production of relevant office of Hawaiian affairs
14 records, and extending to those individuals all rights
15 and recognitions conferred upon other members of the
16 roll."


