# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CERTAIN FUNDS UNDER THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that certain funds in the
- 2 department of labor and industrial relations are classified and
- 3 operated incongruently from their statutory designations.
- 4 According to the state auditor's report no. 12-10, issued on
- 5 December 7, 2012, the confusion in classifying funds may be due
- 6 to the inconsistency between the name given to the fund by the
- 7 statute that establishes it; the definitions provided by the
- 8 department of accounting and general services; and the
- 9 definitions of special, revolving, and trust funds contained in
- 10 the Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to clarify the classification of
- 12 four funds of the department of labor and industrial relations
- 13 as trust funds as recommended by the state auditor.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 36-27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 16 "(a) Except as provided in this section, and
- 17 notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, from time to

18	the legislature, the director shall report all central service
19	assessments made during the preceding fiscal year."

22	payable pursuant to this chapter shall be paid from the fund.

- 13 and (g), 392-45, 392-46, 392-47, 392-52, 392-62, 392-63, 392-64,
- 14 392-65, 392-67, 392-69, 392-72(a), 392-78(d), and 392-92(b),
  - 15 Hawaii Revised Statutes, are amended by substituting the word
  - 16 "trust fund" or like term, wherever the words "special fund" or
  - 17 like term appears, as the context requires.
  - 18 SECTION 9. To conform to the change in the name "special
  - 19 fund for premium supplementation" to "trust fund for premium
  - 20 supplementation, "sections 393-33(a) and 393-34(b), Hawaii
  - 21 Revised Statutes, are amended by substituting the words "trust

- 3 SECTION 10. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 11. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 6 provided that the amendments made to sections 36-27(a) and 36-
- 7 30(a), Hawaii Revised Statutes, under sections 2 and 3 of this
- 8 Act respectively, shall not be repealed when those sections are
- 9 reenacted on June 30, 2015, pursuant to section 34 of Act 79,
