A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII PAROLING AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 353-61, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) Members of the paroling authority shall be nominated
4	by a panel composed of the chief justice of the Hawaii supreme
5	$court[_{7}]$ or the chief justice's designee, the director[_{7}] or the
6	director's designee, the president of the Hawaii State Bar
7	Association[τ] or the president's designee, a representative
8	designated by the head of the Interfaith Alliance Hawaii, a
9	member from the general public to be appointed by the governor,
10	and the president of the Hawaii chapter of the National
11	Association of Social Workers[-] or the president's designee.
12	The panel shall submit to the governor the names of not less
13	than three persons, designated as the nominees, for chairperson
14	or as a member, for each vacancy. The requirement for
15	nomination by the panel established under this section shall
16	only apply to a nominee's nomination by the governor to an
17	initial term on the paroling authority and not to any subsequent
18	consecutive term of a sitting paroling authority member or

1	chairpers	on whose initial appointment to office was made
2	pursuant	to a nomination by the panel."
3	SECT	ION 2. Section 353-62, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4	amended b	y amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
5	" (b)	In its operations, the paroling authority shall:
6	(1)	Keep and maintain a record of all meetings and
7		proceedings;
8	(2)	Make public no more than thirty days after a parole
9		release hearing the following information:
10		(A) The prisoner's name; and
11		(B) Whether the parole request was approved or
12		denied;
13	[(2)]	(3) Send a detailed report of its operations to the
14		governor every three months;
15	[-(3) -]	(4) In promulgating rules, conform to chapter 91;
16	[(4)	In all matters (5) Allow each prisoner a hearing
