Dear President Kim, Speaker Souki, and Members of the Legislature:

Pursuant to the notice requirement of Section 16 of Article III of the Constitution of the State of Hawaii, I am transmitting herewith a proclamation giving notice of my plan to return the following bill with my objections:

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, under Section 16 of Article III of the Constitution of the State of Hawaii, the Governor is required to give notice, by a proclamation, of the Governor's plan to return with the Governor's objections any bill presented to the Governor less than ten days before adjournment sine die or presented to the Governor after adjournment sine die of the Legislature; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 909, entitled "A Bill for an Act Making Appropriations for Collective Bargaining Cost Items," passed by the Legislature, was presented to the Governor within the aforementioned period; and

WHEREAS, under Section16 of Article III, the Governor may veto any specific item or items in any bill that appropriates money for specific purposes by striking out or reducing the same; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 909 appropriates money for specific purposes and certain appropriation items in that bill are unacceptable to the Governor of the State of Hawaii;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, NEIL ABERCROMBIE, Governor of the State of Hawaii, do hereby issue this proclamation, pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of Article III of the Constitution of the State of Hawaii, giving notice of my plan to return Senate Bill No. 909 with my objections to certain appropriation items contained therein to the Legislature as provided by said Section 16 of Article III of the Constitution.
