A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The intent of this Act is to incentivize
2 partnership and investment in programs specifically designed to
3 assist the offender population in transitioning to the community
4 in a safe, responsible manner. This Act provides funds for
5 holistic treatment and support services designed to enable
6 participants from the ex-offender population to achieve self-
7 sufficiency. These programs should include partnership with the
8 department of public safety.

9 SECTION 2. The department of labor and industrial
10 relations is authorized until June 30, 2014, to receive monetary
11 donations and to expend the moneys collected for:

12 (1) Programs specifically designed to assist the offender
13 population in transitioning to the community in a
14 safe, responsible way;

15 (2) Holistic treatment and support services designed to
16 enable participants from the ex-offender population to
17 achieve self-sufficiency; and

18 (3) Other purposes of this Act.




1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$250,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 for
4 expenses incurred for reintegration support, job training,
5 employment placement, and case management, including through
6 programs in partnership with the department of public safety,
7 for persons convicted of crimes and reentering the community.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
9 labor and industrial relations for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
