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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 201-72.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) There is established an aerospace advisory committee  
4 within the office of aerospace development of the department of  
5 business, economic development, and tourism for administrative  
6 purposes. The committee shall be composed of [~~sixteen~~] fifteen  
7 members appointed by the governor, as provided in section 26-34,  
8 except as otherwise provided in this section. Of the [~~sixteen~~]  
9 fifteen members:

10 (1) Three members shall be representatives of the  
11 aerospace industry. One member shall be appointed  
12 from a list of nominees submitted by the president of  
13 the senate, and one member shall be appointed from a  
14 list of nominees submitted by the speaker of the house  
15 of representatives;

16 (2) Three members shall be representatives of the  
17 aerospace industry in this State. One member shall be  
18 appointed from a list of nominees submitted by the



- 1 president of the senate, and one member shall be  
2 appointed from a list of nominees submitted by the  
3 speaker of the house of representatives;
- 4 (3) One member shall be a representative of investment  
5 banking;
- 6 (4) Four members shall represent the economic development  
7 boards of Kauai, Oahu, Maui, and Hawaii, respectively,  
8 to be appointed, respectively, from a list of nominees  
9 submitted by each of these economic development  
10 boards;
- 11 (5) [~~Four~~] Three members shall represent [~~the department~~  
12 ~~of education,~~] the University of Hawaii at Manoa,  
13 [~~the~~] University of Hawaii at Hilo, and [~~the~~]  
14 University of Hawaii community college system,  
15 respectively, to be appointed, one each, from a list  
16 of nominees submitted by [~~the department of~~  
17 ~~education,~~] the University of Hawaii at Manoa, [~~the~~]  
18 University of Hawaii at Hilo, and [~~the~~] University of  
19 Hawaii community college system, respectively; and
- 20 (6) One member, not appointed under paragraphs (1) through  
21 (5) of this subsection, to serve as chairperson, who  
22 shall have experience, knowledge, and expertise in

2 and state aerospace industry."

3 SECTION 2. Section 205A-62, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
4 amended to read as follows:

5 "[+]§205A-62[+] Duties and responsibilities of the lead  
6 agency. The lead agency shall have the following duties and  
7 responsibilities:

- 8 (1) Coordinate overall implementation of the plan, giving  
9 special consideration to the plan's priority  
10 recommendations;
- 11 (2) Review and periodically update the plan;
- 12 (3) Coordinate the development of state agency work plans  
13 to implement the ocean resources management plan. The  
14 work plans shall be revised on a biennial basis and  
15 coordinated with the budget process. State agencies  
16 with responsibilities relating to marine and coastal  
17 zone management include but are not limited to:
- 18 (A) The department of agriculture;
- 19 (B) The department of business, economic development,  
20 and tourism;
- 21 (C) The department of defense;
- 22 [~~D~~] The ~~department of education,~~



- 1           ~~(E)~~ (D) The department of health;
- 2           ~~(F)~~ (E) The department of land and natural  
3           resources;
- 4           ~~(G)~~ (F) The department of public safety;
- 5           ~~(H)~~ (G) The department of transportation; and
- 6           ~~(I)~~ (H) The University of Hawaii;
- 7           (4) Ensure that state agency work plans are closely  
8           coordinated with the work plans of relevant federal  
9           and county agencies;
- 10          (5) Analyze, resolve conflicts between, and prioritize, in  
11          cooperation with relevant agencies and as part of the  
12          work plan development process, the sector-specific  
13          recommendations included in the plan;
- 14          (6) Coordinate exclusive economic zone and other marine-  
15          related issues with state and county agencies;
- 16          (7) Provide technical assistance to the agencies on policy  
17          and issue-related matters regarding marine and coastal  
18          resources management;
- 19          (8) Coordinate marine and coastal education activities;  
20          and
- 21          (9) Adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 to carry out the  
22          purposes of this part."



1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
