A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PLANNED COMMUNITY ASSOCIATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to ensure that all
- 2 members of a planned community association are able to receive
- 3 notice of any regular annual meeting or special meeting of the
- 4 association.
- 5 SECTION 2. Chapter 421J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 6 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 7 and to read as follows:
- 8 "S421J- Notice required. (a) Not less than fourteen
- 9 days in advance of any regular annual meeting or special meeting
- 10 of an association, the secretary or other officer specified in
- 11 the bylaws shall give written notice of the meeting to each
- member of the association as provided in the bylaws of the
- association or by two or more of the following means:
- 14 (1) Hand delivery;
- 15 (2) United States mail sent to the mailing address of each
- 16 unit or to another mailing address designated in
- writing by the association member;

1	(3)	Electronic mail to the electronic mailing address
2		designated in writing by the association member; or
3	(4)	Posting of the meeting notice in its entirety on a
4		portion of the association's website that is
5		accessible to all members.
6	(b)	Notice pursuant to this section shall state:
7	(1)	The date, time, and place of the meeting; and
8	(2)	The items on the agenda, including the general nature
9		of and rationale for any proposed amendment to the
10		declaration or bylaws; any proposal for a special
11		assessment, unless the authority for a special
12		assessment is otherwise provided for in the
13		association's governing documents; and any proposal to
14		remove a member of the board.
15	<u>(c)</u>	The requirements of this section shall not be
16	interpret	ed to preclude any association member from proposing an
17	amendment	to the declaration or bylaws or proposing to remove a
18	member of	the board at an association meeting.
19	<u>(đ)</u>	The requirements of this section shall not be
20	interprete	ed to apply to any board meetings or committee meetings
21	of a planned community association."
