A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CARE HOMES.

	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:
1	SECTION 1. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§321- Care homes; liability insurance; coverage. (a)
5	All operators of adult foster homes under section 321-11.2,
6	adult residential care homes, assisted living facilities,
7	community care foster family homes as defined in section
8	321-481, developmental disabilities domiciliary homes as defined
9	in section 321-15.9, and expanded adult residential care homes
10	as defined in section 321-15.1, shall obtain and maintain the
11	following in coverage amounts deemed sufficient and appropriate
12	by the department of health:

- 13 (1) Liability insurance with respect to their operation of 14 the homes or facilities; and
- 15 (2) Automobile liability insurance, including adequate 16 bodily injury liability coverage for vehicles used to **17** transport residents of the homes or facilities.

- 5 SECTION 3. Section 321-11.2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 6 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 7 "(a) The department of health is authorized to certify
- 8 adult foster homes for [developmentally disabled] individuals
- 9 with developmental disabilities or intellectual disabilities
- 10 requiring such care beyond the eighteenth birthday. "Adult
- 11 foster home" means a private home providing care on a twenty-
- 12 four hour basis for adults with developmental or intellectual
- 13 disabilities. To be certified, an adult foster home shall have
- 14 not more than two adults with developmental or intellectual
- 15 disabilities at the same time, who are unrelated to the foster
- 16 family. The director of health may waive the two adult limit
- 17 for certification of that home as an adult foster home; provided
- 18 that the number of adults with developmental or intellectual
- 19 disabilities in the certified home shall not exceed three adults
- 20 with developmental or intellectual disabilities. To accommodate
- 21 residents of a foster boarding home for children with
- 22 developmental or intellectual disabilities who reach the age of

1 eighteen years, where the home is certified as a foster boarding 2 home for children under section 346-17, the director of health 3 may waive the two adult limit for certification of that home as 4 an adult foster home, provided that: (1) the number of foster 5 children and adults in such dually certified home shall not 6 exceed five, and (2) no new adults may be admitted into the home 7 while there are any foster children residing in the home." 8 SECTION 4. Section 321-11.7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 9 amended to read as follows: "[+]\$321-11.7 Care homes; liability insurance; 10 11 coverage.[]] (a) All operators of adult foster homes under 12 section 321-11.2 [and], adult residential care homes, assisted living facilities, developmental disabilities domiciliary homes 13 as defined in section 321-15.9, and expanded adult residential 14 care homes as defined in section 321-15.1 shall obtain and 15 16 maintain [liability] the following in coverage amounts deemed 17 sufficient and appropriate by the department of health: 18 (1) Liability insurance with respect to their operation of the homes or facilities [in-a coverage amount deemed 19

sufficient by the department.

18	SECT	ION 5. Act 221, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011, is		
19	amended by amending section 5 to read as follows:

21	provided that on [June 30, 2013,] July 1, 2014, this Act shall			
22	be repealed [and sections 346-331 and 346-334, Hawaii Revised

- 3 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 6 provided that:
- 7 (1) Section 1 shall take effect on July 1, 2014;
- 8 (2) Section 5 shall take effect on June 29, 2013; and
- 9 (3) Sections 2 and 4 shall be repealed on July 1, 2014.
