A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) There is established a working group to 2 review issues relating to the transition of oversight of home and community-based facilities from the department of human 3 services to the department of health, including services offered 4 by or issues related to: 5 Community care foster family homes; 6 (1) (2) Adult residential care homes; 7 8 (3) Adult day care centers; 9 (4) Caregivers of persons with developmental or 10 intellectual disabilities; 11 (5) Adult foster homes; 12 (6) Licensed case management agencies; and Fees, rules, and regulations that affect all of these 13 (7) care setting providers. 14 The working group shall be convened by the chairs of 15 (b) 16 the house of representatives and senate committees on human 17 services. The working group shall consist of:

1	(1)	the chairs of the house of representatives and senate
2		committees on human services, who shall serve as co-
3		chairs;
4	(2)	One representative from the department of human
5		services;
6	(3)	One representative from the department of health;
7	(4)	Four representatives of community care foster family
8		homes, of which two representatives shall be appointed
9		by the senate president and two representatives shall
10		be appointed by the speaker of the house of
11	V.	representatives;
12	(5)	Four representatives of adult residential care homes,
13		of which two representatives shall be appointed by the
14		senate president and two representatives shall be
15 ·		appointed by the speaker of the house of

17	(6)	Two representatives from adult day care centers, of
18		which one representative shall be appointed by the
19		senate president and one representative shall be
20		appointed by the speaker of the house of

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- participation in the working group.(d) The working group shall submit a written report of its
- 19 findings and recommendations, including any proposed
 20 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
 21 to the convening of the regular session of 2014.
- (e) The working group shall terminate on June 30, 2014.
