A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RECYCLING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 36-27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 Except as provided in this section, and 4 notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, from time to time, the director of finance, for the purpose of defraying the 5 6 prorated estimate of central service expenses of government in 7 relation to all special funds, except the: 8 Special out-of-school time instructional program fund (1) 9 under section 302A-1310; 10 (2) School cafeteria special funds of the department of 11 education; 12 (3) Special funds of the University of Hawaii; 13 State educational facilities improvement special fund; (4)14 (5) Convention center enterprise special fund under 15 section 201B-8; 16 (6) Special funds established by section 206E-6; 17 (7) Housing loan program revenue bond special fund;

- 9 assessments made during the preceding fiscal year."
- 10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 13 provided that the amendments made to section 36-27(a), Hawaii
- 14 Revised Statutes, by section 1 of this Act shall not be repealed
- 15 when section 36-27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is reenacted on
- 16 June 30, 2015, by section 34 of Act 79, Session Laws of Hawaii
