

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that hiring students at
2 universities benefits both the student and the university.
3 Hired students have the ability to earn income as they are
4 learning from their jobs either on-campus or off-campus. Many
5 campus programs are highly dependent on entry level, as well as
6 experienced and specialized, flexible staff. At the University
7 of Hawaii, approximately four thousand students work an average
8 of twelve hours per week while enrolled as full-time students.
9 These student employees depend on part-time work to help pay for
10 tuition and educational and living expenses. The University of
11 Hawaii spends approximately \$22,000,000 system-wide for
12 undergraduate and graduate student employees, funded by general
13 funds, tuition and fees, and federal work-study funds.

14 The purpose of this Act is to provide funds for the
15 University of Hawaii to pay student employee salaries at new or
16 expanded worksites on each campus.

17 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$500,000 or so much



1 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 to fund
2 students employed at new or expanded worksites at each
3 University of Hawaii campus; provided that:


4 (1) The vice chancellor for students at each University of
5 Hawaii campus shall be allocated funds according to
6 full-time student enrollment; and

7 (2) Funding priority may be given to students employed for
8 university programs supporting access, retention, and
9 diversity over other student employees.

10 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of
11 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
