
A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3 read as follows:


4 "§8- Human Trafficking Awareness Month. The month of
5 January shall be known and designated as "Human Trafficking
6 Awareness Month" to promote public awareness of human
7 trafficking as a significant societal and public health crisis.
8 This month is not and shall not be construed to be a state
9 holiday."


10 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.


11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.


