
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
TWENTY-NINTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$23,810,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2013-2014
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the twenty-
6 ninth representative district, as follows:

7 1. To be expended by the department of education

8 A. McKinley high school

9 Design, construction, and

10 equipment for renovations to

11 Building W, including temporary

12 portables during construction;

13 ground and site improvements;

14 equipment and appurtenances.

14 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
15 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
16 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
17 provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are
18 unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date.

19 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital
20 improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by
21 the designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
