# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO IRRIGATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Reliable irrigation systems are the lifelines  
2 of Hawaii's agricultural industry. To ensure that Hawaii's  
3 agricultural crops receive a steady and dependable supply of  
4 water, sufficient funding is needed to maintain and improve  
5 Hawaii's irrigation systems. Increasing and extended water  
6 droughts have highlighted the need for the repair and  
7 maintenance of the irrigation systems in the State.

8 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for  
9 improvements to irrigation systems throughout the State.

10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$120,000 or so much  
12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 for the  
13 purpose of making improvements to the following irrigation  
14 systems:

15 1. East Kauai irrigation system.

16 Total funding \$75,000



1           2.    Peekauai Ditch irrigation system,  
2                     also known as Menehune Ditch, and  
3                     all appurtenances thereto.

4           Total funding   \$45,000

5           The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department  
6    of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.

7           SECTION 3.  This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
