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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC LANDS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the nine-hundred-  
2 ninety-nine-year homestead program is becoming increasingly  
3 difficult to manage, because conflicts often arise between  
4 family members who may have an interest in a nine-hundred-  
5 ninety-nine-year lease. Existing leases are unique because they  
6 can only be assigned to members of the lessee's family.

7           The purpose of this Act is to expand the eligibility of  
8 potential assignees of a homestead lease to include trustees of  
9 land trusts created for the purposes of managing and holding a  
10 homestead for the benefit of the lessee and lessee's family  
11 members.

12           SECTION 2. Section 171-99, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
13 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:

14           "(e) Assignment; certificate of occupation or homestead  
15 lease. No existing certificate of occupation or existing  
16 homestead lease, or fractional interest thereof, shall be  
17 transferable or assignable except by conveyance, devise,  
18 bequest, or intestate succession and with the prior approval of



1 the board of land and natural resources; provided that transfer  
2 or assignment by conveyance, devise, or bequest shall be limited  
3 to a member or members of the occupier's or lessee's family[-]  
4 or in the case of a homestead lease, to any person or persons  
5 designated as a trustee of a land trust.

6 For the purposes of this section[, ~~"family"~~]:

7 "Family" means the spouse, reciprocal beneficiary,  
8 children, parents, siblings, grandparents, grandchildren,  
9 nieces, nephews, a parent's siblings, children of a parent's  
10 siblings, and grandchildren of a parent's siblings, of the  
11 occupier or lessee.

12 "Land trust" means a trust created for the purposes of  
13 managing and holding the homestead leasehold estate for the  
14 benefit of the lessee and lessee's family members. The lessee  
15 may be the trustee of the trust.

16 All the successors shall be subject to the performance of  
17 the unperformed conditions of the certificate of occupation or  
18 the homestead lease."


19 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
