
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The intent of this Act is to incentivize
2 partnership and investment in programs specifically designed to
3 assist the offender population in transitioning to the community
4 in a safe, responsible manner. The purpose of this Act is to
5 provide matching funds for holistic treatment and support
6 services designed to enable participants from the ex-offender
7 population to achieve self-sufficiency. These programs should
8 include partnership with the department of public safety. Funds
9 will be released upon commitment of matching funds by an outside
10 entity, public or private.

11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for
14 competitively bid program expenses incurred for reintegration
15 support, job training, employment placement, and case management
16 for persons convicted of crimes and reentering the community;
17 provided that no funds shall be made available under this Act



1 unless matching funds are provided by an outside entity, public
2 or private, for the purpose for which the sum is appropriated.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
4 labor and industrial relations for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2075.
